

The words of Rabbi Winter made a real difference to the talmidim, as depicted by the words of MTI talmid Moshe Shtern, "I heard how Hashem wants us to daven for siyata dishmaya to daven. It was inspiring to know that when we struggle, Hashem just wants us to daven to be able to learn and daven better. Sometimes it's just about perspective."
